Pre Tanning Instructions:

Cleansing: Make sure areas are clean, free of oil, & moisturizer. Exfoliating is an option.

Shaving: Shave the night before.

Deodorant: Do not use deodorant or perfume prior to airtanning.

Waxing: Do not Airtan within 4 days after waxing. Wax residue will block tanner absorption.

Attire: Bring loose fitting clothes that will not rub on the areas sprayed.



Post Tanning Instructions:

Instant Gratification Tan: The color you immediately see is a temporary bronzing color.

Developing: The tanner continues to develop slightly over the next 24 hours.

Careful Time: Wait **5 hours** to swim, shower, wash or take part in vigorous exercise.

Washing: When you shower after 5 hours the temporary color will come off but the tan will remain.

Note:

Not suitable for sufferers of psoriasis, eczema, cuts, & abrasions, or during first 3 months of pregnancy.

According to the American Academy of Dermatology, the most effective products available are sunless tanners that contain **Dihydroxyacetone** (DHA) as the active ingredient. It is a colorless sugar that interacts with the dead skin cells located in the stratum corneum of the epidermis. As the sugar interacts with the dead skin cells, a color change occurs. (The tanner reacts only with the uppermost layers & is not absorbed into the body.) This change usually lasts about 5-7 days from initial application. Every day millions of dead skin cells are sloughed off or worn away from the surface of your skin. This is why tans from sunless methods will gradually fade as the dead skin cells are worn away, so is your tan. For this reason it is suggested that you reapply the sunless tanner every five days to maintain the "tan".
